## AUGUST

**Churchill Scholarship:** One year of graduate study in STEM at Cambridge University. Campus deadline: mid-August

**Fulbright U.S. Student Program:** One year of international research, study, or English teaching. Campus deadline: mid-August

**Knight-Hennessy Scholarship:** Any masters, PhD or professional degrees at Stanford for creative problem-solving leaders in all fields. Campus deadline: August 1

**Marshall Scholarship:** Two years' graduate study in the UK in all fields. Scholars are intellectually very strong, have significant leadership potential in their fields, and can explain how they will contribute to the UK throughout their careers. Campus deadline: August 1

**Mitchell Scholarship:** One year of post-graduate study in Ireland /Northern Ireland in all fields. There are three selection criteria: scholarship, leadership, and sustained commitment to public service. Campus deadline: August 1

**Rhodes Scholarship:** Two or more years' graduate study at Oxford University in all fields. Applicants should demonstrate academic excellence, leadership potential in their fields, and the will to "fight the world's fight," Campus deadline: August 1

**Schwarzman Scholarship:** One year Master's program (in English) at Tsinghua University in Beijing with a concentration in International Affairs, Economics and Business, or Public Policy for future leaders in various fields. Campus deadline: August 1

## OCTOBER

**DAAD Scholarships:** Semester and year-long internships/research/study in all fields in Germany. Deadlines vary. Many require university endorsement. Campus deadline for Masters or PhD-level research or study: mid-October

**Gates-Cambridge Scholarship:** Degrees at Cambridge University in all fields. Applicants must show evidence of commitment to improving the lives of others. Deadline: mid-October

**Gilman Scholarship:** Funding for study abroad and internships abroad for students receiving Pell Grants. Deadlines: early October for Spring programs; early March for Summer, Fall or Academic Year programs.

**Goldwater Scholarship:** \$7500 toward study in STEM for those excelling in research. Campus deadline: mid-October

**Luce Scholars Program:** Professional apprenticeships in all fields in South or East Asia under the guidance of leading Asians in the interest of improving American understanding of Asia. Campus deadline: early October

**NSF (National Science Foundation) Graduate Research Fellowship:** \$30,000/year for up to 3 years of research-based study leading to a MS or PhD in STEM and Social Sciences. Deadlines vary by discipline typically late October.

## NOVEMBER

**Beinecke Scholarship:** \$4,000 for senior year and \$30,000 for graduate study in the arts, humanities and social sciences. Applicants must demonstrate exceptional potential for graduate work and financial need. Campus deadline: mid-November

**Boren Scholarship:** Summer, semester, and year-long study in regions critical to US national security. Requires 1-year commitment to federal government employment after graduation (can be deferred). Campus deadline: mid-November

**Critical Language Scholarship (CLS):** Funds intensive summer language institutes in countries with critical languages are spoken. Deadline: mid-November

**Truman Scholarship:** \$30,000 for graduate or professional school for juniors demonstrating commitment to impact through public service, academic promise, and leadership. Campus deadline: mid-November

**Udall Scholarship:** \$7,000 to sophomores and juniors in all fields with the commitment and potential to make significant contributions to the fields of environmental protection, tribal health, or tribal governance. Campus deadline: mid-November

## JANUARY

**Humanity in Action:** 5-week summer community-based research on resisting intolerance and exploring models of action to remedy injustice in either Amsterdam, Atlanta, Berlin, Copenhagen, Detroit, Sarajevo, or Warsaw. Deadline: early January

**Pickering Foreign Affairs Fellowships:** For those interested in careers in the U.S. Foreign Service. Those underrepresented in the Foreign Service or with financial need are encouraged to apply. Deadline: mid-January. See also: CEIP Jr. Fellows Program; and Public Policy & International Affairs, Payne, Rangel Fellowships and Summer Institutes, and Scoville Fellowships.

## FEBRUARY

**Foreign Language and Area Studies (FLAS):** Travel and intensive study of languages of the Middle East and Latin America for Duke undergrad and graduate students. Deadline: mid-February

**Fulbright US-UK Summer Institutes:** Three to six week academic and cultural summer programs for first-years and sophomores. Deadline: late February/ early March
